Includes images and sound effects or music to enhance and add meaning and emphasis to the story and overall presentation. Careful planning has gone into the selection of fonts, graphics, sounds, and other animated features.

Fails to compare and contrast original story to *The Pearl* or does not emphasize the following:

Uses slides but fails to illustrate the story or provide strategies and parallels to *The Pearl* for the audience.

Fails to include a final series of slides that summarizes highlights from the stories. Does not show how story elements parallel the characters, setting, and plotline from *The Pearl*.

Fails to include images, sound effects, or music, or the selection of fonts, graphics, sounds, and other animated features are frequently inappropriate or detract from the content of the presentation.

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
