Adding an HTML Table to a Web Page

You can create a basic HTML table with the table element, its associated elements, and a text editor. You simply add the table element's start tag and end tag. Between the two table tags, you add a table row for each row you want to have in your table. After each table row you add a table header tag or a table data tag for each cell you want to have in that row. Then, you save the plain text file with an .htm or .html extension.
