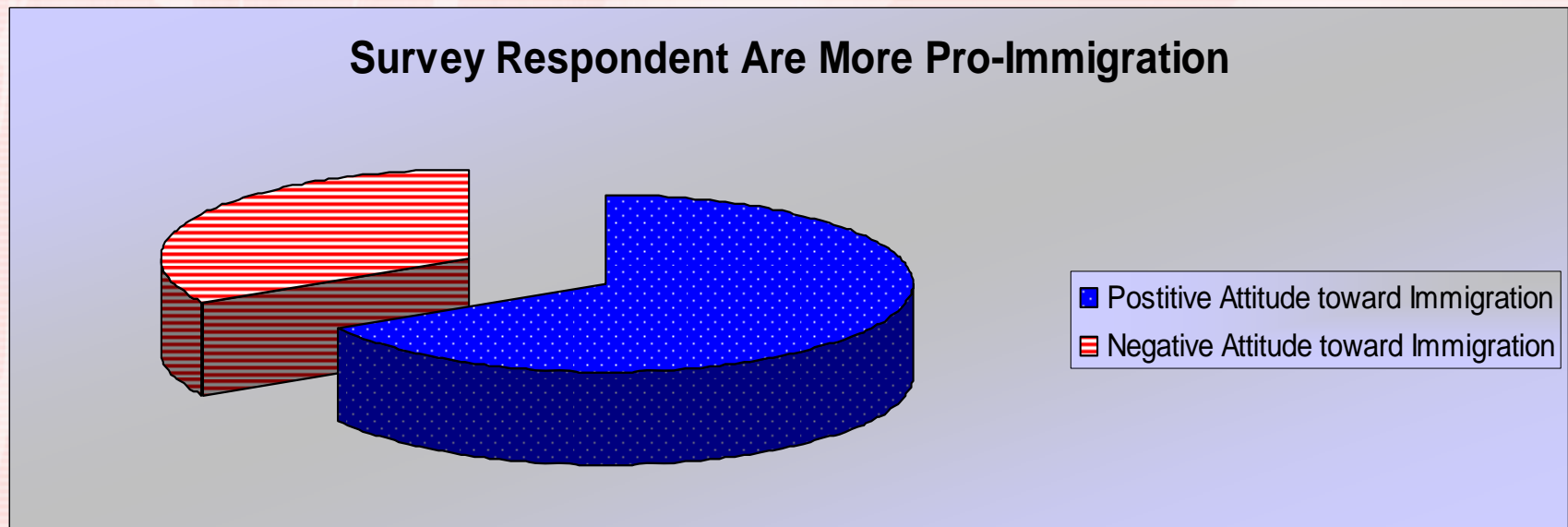

- Secure US Border

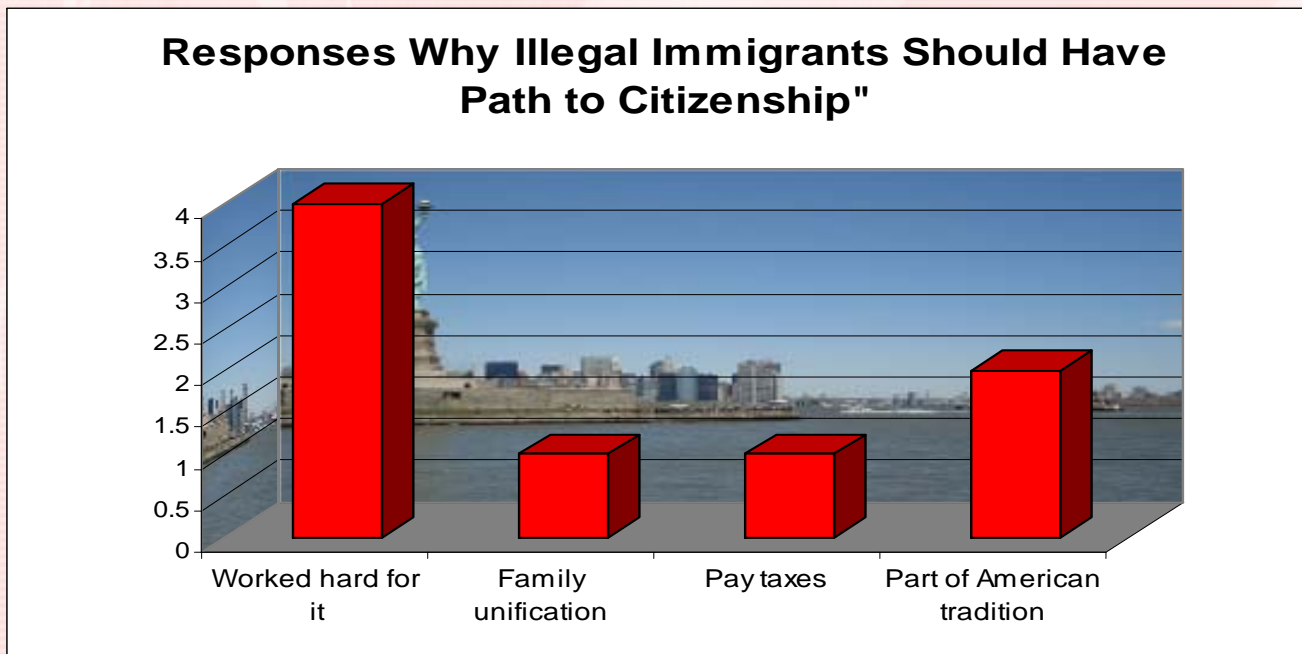
