2. What learning objectives or outcomes do you want students to master?

- 4. What hardware or software do you need to implement the project?
- 5. Is the necessary technology readily available in your classroom or computer lab? Or, will you need to make special arrangements to procure the needed hardware and software?

6. What other materials and supplies do you need to implement the project?

- 7. What arrangements do you need to set up with individuals outside of the classroom to help support the implementation of your unit (parent volunteers, peer tutors, mentors, class partners, and so forth)?
- 8. What authorizations do you need prior to the start of this unit (acceptable use policy or parental consent for e-mail projects, student Web pages, field trips, and so forth)?

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
