Example of a Chain-of-Events Organizer

Chain-of-Events for The Panchatantra Tale – The Blue Jackal

This is a sample graphic organizer a student might create.

First Event

Chandaraka, the Jackal searching for food, enters a village, falls into a bucket of blue dye and becomes a blue animal.

Second Event

He goes back to the forest calls himself a special creation of God and becomes the King of the Jungle.

ThIrd Event

All the animals in the jungle accept the dyed Jackal as their king. He in turn banishes all the Jackals from the jungle.

Fourth Event

One day when the blue Jackal Is holding court, he hears a group of Jackals howling. He begins to loudly respond in his natural voice.

FIfth Event

On hearing the howl, the lions and other animals immediately recognize that their king was after all a Jackal and not a Godsend, pounce on the blue Jackal and kill him.
