- Length of a facilitated course is flexible and determined by your program needs. While the total facilitation content covers 8 hours, there are sample schedules the facilitator may choose to follow or adapt.
- You are permitted to use this content and charge reasonable fees for delivering your course, with the understanding that teachers will receive continuing education credit, based on local requirements.
- Upon completion of a course, Intel asks that you report the number of teachers.

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
