

# Display as a Service

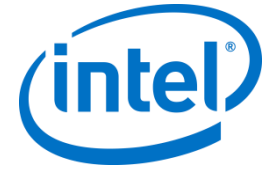

Today, DVD recorders, TV set-top boxes, computers or similar devices are mostly connected to a display using inflexible point-to-point cable connections (e.g. DVI, HDMI). The ability to connect more video sources to one monitor, or one video source to more monitors, or a combination is thereof only possible by adding expensive special hardware.



Display as a Service does all of the above at no extra cost. It also allows to seamlessly move video content from one display or TV to another, which is a great if you would like to view a movie at home while moving from room to room or even to your neighbor's house.
