Upon further consideration of the record and after consultation with the Court's consultants at Stroz Friedberg LLC, I have decided to increase the number of hours for Intel's 30(b)(6) depositions of AMD to 16 hours.

Additionally, Intel's Request for Production number 4 - regarding logs generated during the migration of PSTs into AMD's Enterprise Vault system - will not be allowed, as it is unduly burdensome and appears to represent an attempt to simply fish for errors. I am advised by Stroz Friedberg that these logs would likely be thousands, if not tens of thousands of lines long. Parsing through and explaining voluminous logs would, in my view, be an unwarranted and distracting side show where there is no information gathered during informal discovery to support the suspicion of wide-scale problems with migration.

Not later than close of business January 16, 2009, AMD shall provide an appropriate form of order based on the findings made and conclusions reached during the January 9, 2009 hearing as well as the above stated conclusions. Intel may of course stipulate to both the substance and form

of the order, and in any event as to its form only. Although not required to do so, it would be helpful for Intel to advise whether it intends to consider taking exception to the order.
