## PROPOSED ORDER REGARDING HEWLETT-PACKARD THIRD PARTY DEPOSITIONS AND AMD EXPERT REPORTS

WHEREAS, as reflected in this Court's June 11, 2009 Order Regarding Hewlett-Packard Third Party Depositions, this Court authorized AMD and Intel to take the depositions of certain Hewlett-Packard Company ("HP") witnesses after the June 12, 2009 fact discovery cutoff date on the condition that the depositions be conducted "as expeditiously as possible;"

WHEREAS, on July 2, 2009, AMD completed the deposition of HP witness Richard

Walker, the only available HP deponent of the two it sought leave to depose due to the illness of

the second witness;

WHEREAS, Intel noticed but has not taken the depositions of the two HP witnesses it

sought leave to depose, Scott Stallard and Ted Clark, and will not do so prior to July 20, 2009,

the date by which AMD is required to serve its expert reports;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COURT MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER:

Intel shall sequester all attorneys involved in any manner in the preparations for or taking

of the depositions of Scott Stallard and Ted Clark from AMD's expert reports until after such

depositions have been taken. Such attorneys shall not be given access to any of AMD's expert

reports containing information related to HP, or any information contained in those reports, and

shall not be given any assistance based upon information contained in those expert reports.

AMD's experts shall have seven days following the completion of the latter of the

depositions of Scott Stallard and Ted Clark to revise their reports.
