Dear Judge Poppiti:

To accompany the report the parties submitted yesterday regarding elapsed deposition hours and AMD's submission regarding the status of depositions as a result of Your Honor's June 22 order, we thought it might be helpful to identify a few additional issues that are pending before Your Honor. The first of those issues developed during Your Honor's absence and AMD believes it needs to be addressed on an expedited basis.

AMD submitted a letter to Your Honor yesterday seeking an order requiring Intel to sequester the Intel attorneys who will be involved in two Intel-noticed depositions of Hewlett Packard employees from AMD's expert reports until after those depositions are taken, or to forego taking those depositions at all. Because AMD's expert reports are due to be served on Monday, June 20, AMD respectfully requests that Your Honor address and resolve its motion before that time. Otherwise, the Intel attorneys taking those depositions will presumably obtain access to AMD's expert reports in the ordinary course on Monday, and, as a result, the relief AMD seeks effectively will be denied.

AMD also needs Your Honor's prompt advice regarding the issues addressed in DM 26 and 27, which raise the issue of AMD's ability to obtain and use in this case the EU decision against Intel and its Statement of Objection. AMD would like to cite and rely upon the EU decision in its expert reports and is seeking leave to supplement its reports if it obtains that discovery. Because of their potential impact on AMD's expert reports, AMD respectfully requests that Your Honor also address these matters as soon as it is convenient to do so.
