**STIPULATION AND CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 14**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Paragraph 4 of Case Management Order No. 12, AMD has timely served its preliminary list of exhibits it may seek to introduce during its case-in-chief;

WHEREAS, also pursuant to Paragraph 4 of Case Management Order No, 12, Intel has advised AMD of those categories where it has admissibility objections to a broad category of exhibits, and that it otherwise does not have authenticity or admissibility objections to any broad category of exhibits (as opposed to individualized objections);

WHEREAS, also pursuant to Paragraph 4 of Case Management Order No, 12, AMD and Intel have met and conferred and have reached agreement on a schedule for service of Intel's preliminary exhibit list, service of AMD's preliminary rebuttal exhibit list, and service of Intel's and AMD's respective individualized objections to the other's exhibits..

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby stipulated by and between AMD and Intel, through their respective counsel of record and subject to the approval of the Court, as follows:

1. Not later than November 18, 2009, Intel shall serve its preliminary list of exhibits it may seek to introduce during its case in chief.
2. Not later than November 19, 2009, Intel shall serve its individualized objections to the exhibits listed in AMD's preliminary exhibit list served on October 19, 2009.
3. Not later than December 4, 2009, AMD shall serve its preliminary list of rebuttal exhibits.
4. Not later than December 10, 2009, AMD shall serve its individualized objections to the exhibits listed in Intel's preliminary exhibit list to be served on November 16, 2009, and Intel shall serve its individualized objections to the exhibits listed in AMD's preliminary list of rebuttal exhibits to be served on December 4, 2009.


