Dear Judge Poppiti:

The parties provide this joint report pursuant to Amended Case Management Order No. 6, dated June 20, 2008, which requires within fifteen days of the end of every second month that the parties "jointly report on the number of hours of depositions each has expended during the preceding two months and any issues relating to the progress of the depositions, or any other issues, that have arisen in connection with the depositions."

Number of Hours of Depositions Expended by Each Side

During the preceding two months, July and August, the parties expended the following numbers of hours: For depositions taken in July, Intel 26.0 hours, AMD and Class 68.5 hours. In August, for depositions for which the court reporters have delivered the finalized deposition transcripts to the parties, Intel 8.0 hours, AMD and Class 20.75 hours. Thus, the totals for the two months are, Intel 34.0 hours, AMD and Class 89.25 hours.

For Your Honor's information, for a deposition taken on August 28 the parties have not been able to tabulate the time used by each side from the rough transcript and the final transcript is not yet available. The hours used in this deposition will be included in the parties' next joint report to the Court on November 15, 2008.

Other Issues in Connection with Depositions

There are no issues relating to the progress of the depositions or any other issues that have arisen in connection with the depositions that the parties believe presently require Your Honor's attention.
