ORDER GRANTING UNOPPOSED MOTION OF NON-PARTIES ACER AMERICA CORPORATION AND GATEWAY, INC. FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME TO MOVE TO QUASH OR TO LIMIT SUBPOENAS *DUCES TECUM*

On March 3, 2010, non-parties Acer America Corporation and Gateway, Inc. ("Acer and Gateway") submitted an Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to Move to Quash or Limit ("Motion") the Federal Trade Commission's Subpoenas *Duces Tecum*, received by the agents for service of process by Acer and Gateway on March 2, 2010 ("Subpoenas").

According to the Motion, Acer and Gateway are in the process of negotiating in an attempt to resolve concerns regarding the scope and burden created by the Subpoenas. The Motion states that Acer's and Gateway's time to file a motion to quash or limit the Subpoenas is March 11, 2010. The Motion further states that, given the scope of the document requests and the complexity of the issues, more time is required for Acer and Gateway to effectively complete their negotiations with Complaint Counsel.

The Motion states that Complaint Counsel has agreed to an initial extension of time for Acer and Gateway to file a motion to quash or limit the subpoena to March 22, 2010.

Based on the foregoing, the Motion is GRANTED, and it is hereby ORDERED that Acer and Gateway shall have until March 22, 2010 to file a motion to quash or limit the Subpoenas served upon them by Complaint Counsel, and further, that Acer's and

Gateway's obligation to respond to the Subpoena shall be tolled during this extension period.
