**SECOND UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

Non-party Hewlett-Packard Company (“HP”) files this second motion to extend the time permitted for HP to move to limit the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* served on it by Intel Corporation (“Intel”).

Intel served HP with the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* on Friday, March 19, 2010. Under the applicable procedures of the Federal Trade Commission Rules of Practice, the time to file a Motion to Limit or Quash Intel’s Subpoena *Duces Tecum* is March 29, 2010.

Intel does not oppose to this second extension of time for HP to file a Motion to Limit or Quash the Subpoena *Duces Tecum* through April 22, 2010, while the parties try to reach agreement on the scope of the Subpoena *Duces Tecum*. HP previously filed an Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time in regards to the Intel Subpoena *Duces Tecum* on March 26, 2010, which was granted on March 29, 2010.

Accordingly, HP respectfully requests that this Second Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time be granted and that HP be given until April 22, 2010 to file a Motion to Quash or Limit Intel’s Subpoena *Duces Tecum*.

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
