
**ORDER GRANTING THIRD UNOPPOSED MOTION OF NON-PARTY
LENOVO GROUP LIMITED FOR EXTENSION OF TIME
TO MOVE TO LIMIT OR QUASH SUBPOENA *DUCES TECUM***

On April 27, 2010, non-party Lenovo Group Limited (“Lenovo”) submitted a third unopposed motion for extension of time to move to limit or quash a Subpoena *Duces Tecum* received from Complaint Counsel on March 22, 2010 (“Subpoena”). Lenovo seeks an extension of time until May 4, 2010. Lenovo previously received extensions of time to move to limit or quash the Subpoena, through April 25, 2010. *See* Orders Granting Unopposed Motion of Non-Party Lenovo Group Limited for Extension of Time to Move to Limit or Quash Subpoena *Duces Tecum*, dated April 1, 2010 and April 15, 2010.

Lenovo states that it is continuing its discussions with Complaint Counsel to resolve Lenovo’s concerns regarding the Subpoena and that, to facilitate those discussions and potentially avoid the necessity of filing a motion to limit or quash, Lenovo and Complaint Counsel have agreed that Lenovo may have a seven day extension of time, through May 4, 2010. In connection with the extension of time, Lenovo further requests that its obligation to otherwise respond to the Subpoena be tolled during the period of the extension.

Based on the foregoing, Lenovo’s Third Unopposed Motion for Extension of Time to Move to Limit or Quash Subpoena *Duces Tecum* is GRANTED, and it is hereby ORDERED that Lenovo shall have until May 4, 2010 to file a motion to quash or limit the subpoena received from Complaint Counsel on March 22, 2010, and that Lenovo’s obligation to otherwise respond to the Subpoena shall be tolled during the extension period.
