**[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING INTEL'S MOTION UNDER  
RULE 3.36 FOR LEAVE TO TAKE A DEPOSITION OF  
THE BUREAU OF LABOR STATISTICS UNDER RULE 3.33(c)(1)**

Respondent Intel Corporation, having moved on May 27, 2010, for leave to take a deposition of the Bureau of Labor Statistics pursuant to Rule 3.33(c)(1); and

Good cause having been shown,

**IT IS ORDERED** that

1. The subject matter of the Rule 3.33(c)(1) deposition of the Bureau of Labor Statistics ("BLS") of the U.S. Department of Labor is relevant to issues in Intel Corporation, FTC Dkt. No. 9341.
2. The deposition sought by Intel is for two hours or less and designed to impose a minimal burden on BLS' personnel and resources.
3. The subject matter of the deposition is designed to protect individual company data and the details of the internal methodology used by the BLS consistent with the need for Intel to acquire relevant information.
