Product Version

Lumension* Endpoint Management and Security Suite v7.2

Dependencies / Requirements

- SQL Server 2008 R2 is required.
- The appliance is connected to the Internet.
- Lumension requires a minimum of 32 GB of storage space.

Appliance Default Passwords

To download the current "Appliance Default Password List" (Login required):

- 1. Use a Web browser to go to: <u>www.intelhybridcloud.com/</u>.
- 2. Click the **Login** link and enter your login information.
- 3. At the top of the page, select **Menu** and then click the **Support** link.
- 4. On the Support page, click the **Server Setup & Activation section** to expand it and then click the **Additional Setup Documents** link.
- 5. Click the Additional Setup Documents zip file version that you want to download and then select to save the zip file.
- 6. Extract the Appliance Default Password List from the zip file.
 - NOTE: The default, out-of-the-box experience allows you to specify the passwords for the Microsoft* Windows*-based appliances during configuration. For Linux* appliances, type "passwd" in the shell.

Download

- 1. After the dependencies and requirements are configured and set up, go to the Intel AppUp[®] SMB Service store at: <u>https://store.intelhybridcloud.com</u>.
- 2. Log in using your MSP ID and password.
- 3. Search for and select **Lumension**.
- 4. Select the Intel[®] Hybrid Cloud server.
- 5. Select the Windows-based appliance to install on (the appliance should have SQL Server 2008 R2 installed)
- 6. Click **Add to Order**.
- 7. Complete the ordering process. The appliance will download within 24 hours.

Install

- 1. After Lumension is downloaded and the license key is acquired (see Licenses and Configuration), log in to the Intel[®] Hybrid Cloud server manager.
- 2. Click the **Appliances** button to open the Appliances page. Select the appliance on which Lumension is installed.
- 3. If the appliance is Stopped, click the **Start** button.
- 4. Select the **Console** tab to open the Console page.

- 5. Click the **Launch** button (next to VNC Console) to open the VNC window.
- 6. Enter information and credentials of the administrator in the required fields and then log in to the appliance.
- 7. Go to the folder C:\Lumension_7_2.
- 8. Double-click the **LumensionEMSS_7_20_1275.exe** file. The Microsoft Silverlight installation wizard appears if it is not installed on the appliance. Follow the instructions in the installation wizard.
- 9. The Lumension EMSS InstallShield Wizard appears. Follow the instructions in the InstallShield Wizard.
- 10. If the instance name is not the default instance name:
 - a. Go to the folder C:\Lumension_7_2.
 - b. Right-click the LumensionUsage.exe.config file and open it with a text editor.
 - c. Replace the connection string **localhost\UPC** with the new connection string (*hostname**instance name*). Save the file.

Connect to the Appliance / Application

- 1. Log in to the Intel[®] Hybrid Cloud server manager.
- 2. Click the **Appliances** button to open the Appliances page.
- 3. Select the appliance on which Lumension is installed.
- 4. If the appliance is Stopped, click the **Start** button.
- 5. Select the **Console** tab to open the Console page.
- 6. Click the **Launch** button (next to VNC Console) to open the VNC window.
- 7. Enter information and credentials of the administrator in the required fields and then log in to the appliance.
- 8. Double-click the **Lumension EMSS** shortcut on the desktop.
- 9. Enter information and credentials of the administrator and log in to Lumension.

Licenses / Configuration

To acquire the license:

- 1. Go to the Intel AppUp[®] SMB Service store at: <u>https://store.intelhybridcloud.com</u>.
- 2. Log in using your MSP ID and password.
- 3. Click the **Servers** link.
- 4. Select the Intel Hybrid Cloud server where Lumension 7.2 is installed.
- 5. Click the **Send license via email** link to place a license request. The license key is sent to the email address of the MSP.

Uninstall

- 1. Log in to the Intel Hybrid Cloud server manager.
- 2. Click the **Appliances** button to open the Appliances page.

- 3. Select the appliance where the Lumension application is installed.
- 4. If the appliance is Stopped, click the **Start** button.
- 5. Select the **Console** tab to open the Console page.
- 6. Click the **Launch** button (next to VNC Console) to open the VNC window.
- 7. Enter information and credentials of the domain administrator in the required fields and then log in to the appliance.
- 8. Select Start > Control Panel > Programs > Programs and Features.
- 9. Right-click on **Lumension EMSS** and select **Change**. Follow the directions in the installation wizard.
- 10. Right-click on **LM Agent** and select **Uninstall**. Follow the directions in the installation wizard.
- 11. Right-click on **Lumension Patch Agent** and select **Uninstall** if it exists. Follow the directions in the installation wizard.
- 12. In the Intel Hybrid Cloud server manager, click the **Appliances** button to open the Appliances page.
 - 13. Select the appliance where the Lumension application is installed.
 - 14. Click the **Application** tab.
 - 15. Click the **Lumension** logo.
 - 16. Click the Uninstall button.
 - 17. Select the **Console** tab to open the Console page.
 - 18. Click the **Launch** button (next to VNC Console) to open the VNC window.
 - 19. Select Start > Control Panel > Programs > Programs and Features.
 - 20. Right-click on the **Microsoft SQL Server** component and select **Uninstall**. This starts the SQL server Installation Wizard.
 - 21. On the Select Instance page, select the instance Lumension uses. Follow the uninstallation wizard to completion.

Troubleshooting

Lumension installation fails due to insufficient disk space

- 1. Log in to the Intel Hybrid Cloud server manager.
- 2. Click the **Appliances** button to open the Appliances page.
- 3. Select the appliance where the Lumension application is installed.
- 4. If the appliance is running, click the **Stop** button.
- 5. Select the **Configure** tab and then go to **Storage**.
- 6. Click **Add Usage** and increase the storage beyond the 32 GB required.
- 7. If the appliance is stopped, click the **Start** button.
- 8. Select the **Console** tab to open the Console page.
- 9. Click the Launch button (next to VNC Console) to open the VNC window.

- 10. Enter information and credentials of the **administrator** in the required fields and then log in to the appliance.
- 11. Select **Start > Administrative Tools > Server Manager**.
- 12. Select **Disk Management**, click on the **C** drive and then select **extended volume**. Follow the instructions on screen.
