Download

- 1. Go to the Intel AppUpSM Small Business Service Store at https://store.intelhybridcloud.com.
- 2. Log in using your ID and password.
- 3. Search for and select Remote Desktop Services.
- 4. Select the Intel® Hybrid Cloud server.
- 5. Click Add to Order.
- 6. Complete the ordering process.

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Install

- 1. Log in to the Intel® Hybrid Cloud Server Manager.
- 2. Click the **Appliances** button Appliances page.
- 3. Select the appliance on which Remote Desktop Services is installed.
- 4. If the appliance status is "Stopped," click the **Start** button.
- 5. Select the **Console** tab to open the Console page.
- 6. Click the Launch button next to VNC Console to open the VNC window.
- 7. Enter information and credentials in the required fields and then log in to the appliance.
- 8. Browse to the folder C:\Program Files (x86)\RDS_APP.
- 9. Right-click on Setup.bat and select Run as administrator.
- 10. In the Remote Desktop Services dialog box, fill in the required fields.



11. Click **OK**.

Next, the System will install the RDS roles and perform a reboot of the VM.

RDS will connect to the Microsoft activate server over the Internet and get activated automatically once the system is up and running.

Uninstall

- 1. Log in to the Intel Hybrid Cloud Server Manager.
- 2. Click the **Appliances** button to open the Appliances page.
- 3. Select the **Remote Desktop Services** appliance.
- 4. If the appliance status is "Running," click the **Stop** button.
- 5. Select the **Control** tab.
- 6. Click the Uninstall button.

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How to Connect to the Appliance/Application

- 1. Log in to the Intel Hybrid Cloud Server Manager.
- 2. Click the **Appliances** button Appliances button to open the Appliances page.
- 3. Select the appliance on which Remote Desktop Services is installed.
- 4. If the appliance status is "Stopped," click the **Start** button.
- 5. Select the **Console** tab to open the Console page.
- 6. Click the **Launch** button next to VNC Console to open the VNC window.
- 7. Select Start > Administrative Tools > Remote Desktop Services.
