• QLogic 12005 PT-16 firmware version 1.7 (Cronus\_060210\_v1-7.hex).

Miscellaneous:

- Following are instructions for updating the module firmware:
  - 1. Copy the attached hex file to a desired location on your PC.
  - Edit the Tera Term script file and change the line that calls out fn="c:\PassThrough. hex" to point to the hex file you saved on your PC.
  - 3. Log into the CMC using Tera Term.
  - 4. Type connect switch-zz where zz is the fabric (for example, B1,B2,C1 or C2).
  - 5. At the prompt, start the Tera Term script by choosing Control | Macro.
  - 6. The script scrolls a large amount of hex data this could take 5-10 minutes. Do not close the Tera Term window during this time.
  - 7. Upon completion, the script will automatically reboot the module.
- **NOTE**: Firmware updates must be completed separately for each module.
- **NOTE**: Some older versions of Tera Term do not support this script. Tera Term 4.62 or newer is recommended.
